School Dinners:

The price of dinners is going up in September to £2.18 per day and £10.90 per week. Children moving into Year 3 will need to pay for dinners as the Government Free School Meals initiative for infant children ends at the end of Year 2.

PE Kits:

Please note that most classes will need PE Kit on the FIRST DAY back in September. All children should have a PE kit that contains shorts, t-shirt and pumps. This should be a complete change of clothes from what they are wearing. Whilst we will try to find spare kit if necessary, it is the children's responsibility to bring a kit from home.

School Uniform:

As a reminder, next year's Reception children must wear the school uniform. It is optional for other children, but if they are wearing it then we do insist they wear it correctly. So full uniform along with black school shoes please.

Gold polo shirt (no logo)

Grey trousers / skirt / pinafore

Grey tights / socks

Black school shoes

There will also be the choice for girls to wear a green check summer 'school' dress in the summer.

The gold polo shirt and grey bottoms can be bought from any shop that stocks uniform - Tesco, Asda, Marks and Spencer, Debonair in Ashton and the School Wear shop in Greenfield as they are basic bits of uniform without logos.

Many parents have already bought the sweatshirt and cardigan. For those of you that needed larger sizes, we have placed an order and hope that it will arrive in the first week in September. Thank you for your patience with the sizes we have run out of, we didn't order enough originally!

Please also remember to NAME their uniform as it is hard enough dealing with lost property at the moment.....
