If girls are wearing tights for school, it can be useful to keep some socks in their PE bags. Many children haven't yet got any pumps. Although we do keep some spares in school, they really need to bring their own pair in.

### Reading at home:

We are going to have a real drive this year on children reading at home. Children should spend some time reading at home as often as possible. Reading at home must be recorded in the reading diary. It doesn't have to be a long session



### Parents / Carers of children in Year 1 and 2:

Please can I remind parents of children in Year 1 and Year 2 that an adult needs to stay with them until the bell goes at 8.55am. Teachers are busy before school setting up for the day ahead and can't guarantee being in the classroom until the bell goes at 8.55am.
