Dangerous "24-hour challenge" for children

We have been informed by Tameside Police of a trend on social media which is being used to ask children to take a "24-hour Challenge". This involves children going missing from home for 24 hours, taking no mobile phone or food with them. They are further challenged to be involved in risky behaviour such as climbing onto roofs and buildings. There are cases of children as young as 11 taking up the challenge. We have discussed this with Classes 4 and 5 and pointed out how dangerous it is but felt it was sensible to let parents / carers know too.
