- The sports coach will provide children with the skills that can be transferred to a range of sports and activities that can be used throughout their lives.

- The installation of a trim-trail and use of playground toys will help develop the children's co-ordination, balance and agility through play for years to come.
- The mindfulness programme will give the children a bank of strategies that they will be able to draw upon when required to help them with their physical and mental wellbeing.
- The teacher mindfulness training will ensure that this will become common practise and benefit all children who attend our school now and in the future.
- Having PE kits available for all children will ensure that all children take a full part in all curriculum PE sessions. Therefore all children will have the opportunity to develop key physical skills.
- Being a member of Tameside Sports Partnership will enable the PE lead to gain valuable knowledge and skills to move the subject forward and implement a strong PE culture for years to come.
