



School Uniform Guidance for September

From September, all year groups in school will be wearing a school uniform. In the light of this, and before any shopping is done over the summer, we wanted to remind parents of the uniform expectations. Whilst we do understand that particularly at the end of the academic year, things are outgrown and substitutes have to be found, our hope in sending out these expectations is to provide clarity and ensure we start September in the right uniform looking smart.

Sweatshirt / Cardigan:



We stock and sell the sweatshirt and cardigan ourselves at cost price and are available from the office. A plain bottle green sweatshirt or cardigan is also acceptable. Parents and carers might want to make this choice if our smallest sizes are too large.

T-shirt:

The gold t-shirts go best with the embroidery on the uniform. These are available from many places as they are plain with no logo. Other shades of yellow are acceptable.

Bottoms:

Children can wear grey trousers / shorts / skirts / pinafores. These should be the tailored school type – some examples are given below (other versions are acceptable). We would ask that children don't wear sports shorts and cycling shorts etc.



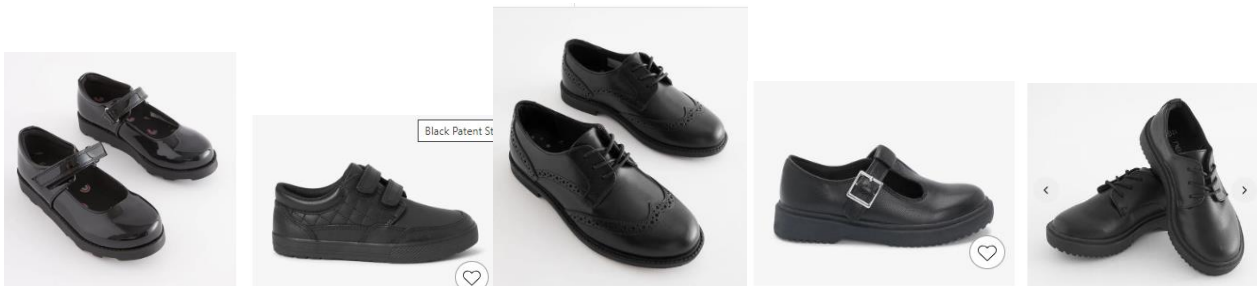
Summer Dress / All in one:

It is also acceptable for children to wear a green checked (or striped) summer dress as shown below:



Footwear:

Children should be wearing black shoes with their uniform and not trainers. We don't mind what style of black shoe they wear, but please make sure they can fasten their laces if they have laces in them! Some examples are below but there are lots of choices.



Children should wear grey tights / socks too.

Other reminders:

If your child is on packed lunches please send them in with a lunch box rather than a large rucksack, we struggle to store the rucksacks when lots of children bring them in.

Children should not wear looped or dangly ear-rings. These are unsafe when playing tig etc.

Children should not wear smart watches that have the ability to receive messages, make emergency calls, take photos etc even if all of these functions are disabled.

Please also make sure that all elements of clothing are named!
