Happy retirement:

School Meal charges and payments in September:

I am also sending out a separate letter about school meals today. Unfortunately, the price has had to rise to £3.25 per meal. This is due to the amount the school is charged for each meal increasing significantly. Even at this new, increased price school are still subsidising the cost for each meal and the price parents pay does not cover what we are charged. Please note that from September we will also be taking payment on School Spider rather than the Tameside website.

Parking:

Even though parking is now further away from school, can I remind parents and carers to park with consideration to those residents who live further up Old Brow and on West grove. We have had issues this week with people double parking in the middle of West Grove. This is a through road and it is therefore illegal and also unacceptable to block the road in this way whilst you walk children down to school. If parents choose to come to school by car then you must park higher up the hill safely and considerately to our neighbours. We strongly advise anyone that can to walk to school.

Walk to School scheme:

The walk to school scheme is continuing next year but I will be increasing the badge threshold to walking three times a week to earn a badge. As a reminder for park and stride children should be walking from the Gillery / train station or the market ground. Please do discuss with your child whether the distance they have walked counts as park and stride as we have a lot of children thinking that walking across the playground counts!



We, at St.George's Church, are delighted to announce that this year, in celebration of 30 years of Heritage Open Days, we will be having an art competition as part of our open weekend.



Saturday, 14th and Sunday, 15th September 2024.

This is open to all children and free to enter. We are inviting up to twenty entries from each school, so are letting you know now in case you wish to host your own mini selections in advance (e.g. a competition per class). The theme is 'Routes, Networks and Connections' and whilst we would be delighted if entries did link to St George's Church, we are happy to accept any piece of art which the children feel fits this theme.


